### Minutes

- Meeting called to order by President Alex at 7:18pm
- Jose M. led us in Prayer
- **Principal Picazo's update** - The school raised \$9,100 on Give Day hoping to finish at \$10,000-\$11,000 when all said and done. This helps with reaching the \$32,000 needed to replace the sound system in the gym. We had 148 donors which included all of the teachers which earned them the right to wear jeans for the month of December. Middle School is preparing for mid-terms. Our students are getting ready for the Christmas and Nativity shows on December 13.
- **Softball update** – Mike B. gave an update on this Saturday's softball tournament. We still need volunteers for the day VIP tent in the afternoon. We are going to need people in the morning – 7am for set up as there are late night games this Friday night which won't allow us to do much the night before. Please use the sign up genius on the chat. The tournament is free to attend but access to Kid zone and VIP area require tickets - \$10 kids, \$20 VIP. Sergios will be doing Pan con Lechon and mariquitas. We are targeting 8:15am for first pitch as we need to vacate the park by 6pm. Captain's meeting on Thursday night to review the rules as some needed to be changed to reflect the time constraints. Don't forget about the silent auction lots of high quality items and





experiences available. We will measure the success of the auction and hopefully roll out for other events. Lastly we will have a table selling tickets to the Gala at the softball tournament . Gala will be held at Trump Doral on April 29<sup>th</sup> and there are three ways to attend – Individual tickets, purchase a table, or sponsor table.

- **Pignic Update** - Orly H. gave an update. Pignic will take place on January 28, 2023. We've secured the Pigs. Participants pay \$300 pig included or \$250 bring their own hog. If you get a corporate sponsor of \$1000 the fee is waived. The event will be held from 11am-6pm. We need to start moving quickly because with the holidays we don't have much time to plan and organize. - **Festival** – David A. provided an update. Festival will be held the first weekend of March. We will need help the weekend before for set up, during the festival, and the Monday after for cleanup. Many of our key volunteer slots need some bench. Our Dad Club booth needs help with organizing the food purchasing and donations and prep. Doc is going to continue doing it this year but his kids have all graduated and we need





to work on a successor. We really would like an apprentice or ideally two apprentices to work with him this year. Two volunteers are better than one to split the load. We are also looking for two slots that need replacing on the executive committee. 1) Operations/equipment manager: this person ensures that all the equipment is in working condition and also fixes anything that breaks down during the festival. Carlos has done this over the years and has agreed to help out this year but wants to hand it over to someone new. Looking for one or ideally two people who are handy that could be his assistants this year and take over for the following festival. 2) The other job needed is procurement of items for the festival. Lastly we are working on a number of new upscale experiences for the festival which we will share in future meetings.
